State Motorcycle and ATV Legislation

This report includes important motorcycle and ATV related legislation introduced in 2014 or carried over from 2013. It includes summaries of new bills that have been introduced since the last report was issued and previously introduced bills that have been amended or have had a change of status or comment. Newly introduced bills are marked with a plus sign (+).
